

CAMPING AT BANBURY CRICKET CLUB

Arrivals: Please do not arrive at the Cricket Club before 12.00 noon on Friday.

*We also advise you to try and avoid arriving between 2.30pm – 3.30pm on Friday as there is a school opposite and parents will be collecting their children.

The address is **Banbury Cricket Club, The Willows Pavilion, Whitepost Road, Bodicote, OX15 4BN**

Please check in with our Campsite Managers on arrival and pitch as directed by them as we are going to be very busy this year!

Directions:

Approach is from the M.40 (Junction 11), following signs to Banbury (A422). Go straight on at 2nd roundabout – Continue via Hennef Way to the large roundabout by Tesco's. Take 1st left at this roundabout, proceed along Oxford Road through the town centre traffic lights and up the hill. Continue for approximately one mile along the Oxford Road (A4260) towards Bodicote passing the Horton Hospital and Sainsbury's on the left. Take the left before the flyover and turn right at a new roundabout to pass over the flyover. At the next mini roundabout take the second exit into Whitepost Road. The Pavilion is a short distance on the right.

Wristbands:

Your wristband collection point is the Festival Information desk in the Cricket Pavilion which is open at the following times:

Friday 12.00pm – 10pm; Saturday 10.00am – 2.00pm

Your Weekend Ticket covers Friday and Saturday night's camping.*

*If you are planning to stay over for the Final Survivors Session on Sunday you will need to pay £5 towards the extra cost of the Cricket Club letting us do this! Please book this in at the desk.

Facilities at the Cricket Club:

Outdoor camping for camper-vans, caravans & tents. There are 24 hour toilets and showers will be available with times designated for ladies and men.

Please note that as the Cricket Club has a Cesspit it will not be possible to empty Chemical toilets. Please take your rubbish and chemical waste home with you.

A water point is available at the front of the building. Pets are allowed but dogs must be kept on a lead and away from the Cricket Pitch.

Food & Drink at the Cricket Club: The Cricket Club will be cooking breakfasts and also have hot meals at designated times, plus snacks, teas and coffees, late-night suppers and bar with Real Ales & Cider. Please do not bring your own drink onto the premises.

Events at the Cricket Club:

This is the venue for Song events and Folk Clubs, Singing Breakfasts, Workshops, Open Sessions and Late night Survivors Sessions.

Shuttle Bus: A shuttle bus service will be running between The Town Hall and Banbury Cricket Club from 5.00 p.m. on Friday until 6.00 p.m. on Sunday. Donations boxes will be on the buses to help towards the cost of running this service. All drivers are volunteers and will be working hard to ensure that you get where you want to and home at the end of evening events. Please be patient and allow plenty of time to get to your event in case buses are full!

Approximately 2 buses an hour. Please allow sufficient time to ensure that you get into town on time! The first bus will leave at 9.30am on Saturday and Sunday. Last bus from the Town Hall leaves at 12.00 midnight on Friday and Saturday and 6.00pm on Sunday.

There is also a local bus service from Whitepost Road near the drive entrance which terminates near the Town Hall (Bus service B2) on Friday and Saturday. A timetable will be available for this bus service on the Festival Information desk in the Pavilion.

We are indebted to Banbury Cricket Club for allowing us to use their premises and the staff will be working very hard over the weekend on our behalf. Please treat this with respect!
