

## INDOOR CAMPING AT THE METHODIST CHURCH HALL

Marlborough Road, Banbury, OX16 5BZ

Open from 3.00pm on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> October – 10.30am on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> October

Facilities: You will need to bring a bedding roll or air-bed and sleeping bag. The rooms for sleeping are upstairs with toilets and a kitchen downstairs. Facilities for making hot drinks and tea, coffee and milk will be available. We ask for a small donation to cover the cost.

**Please note - no consuming of alcohol is allowed at the Methodist Hall.**

Festival Events at the Methodist Hall: This will be the venue for a Festival Concert on Friday and Meet the Artist Sessions on Saturday. The Festival will be running a Festival Café on Friday evening and also on Saturday during events, serving teas, coffees, soft drinks and home-made cakes & rolls. Please support this as profits go towards the Festival. Hobby Horses and Dance Sides will also be gathering here on Saturday and Sunday mornings. This is the base for the Steward's Reception Desk and Dance Sides and Hobby Horses will need to check in here for their wristbands.

The Methodist Church: There are three church services on Sunday – Sunday Morning at 9.15am and 10.30am, and the Church will be using the Kitchen and Main Hall after these services. There will also be a service at 6.00 pm. Please avoid being in the building apart from upstairs in the indoor camping area and in Stewards Reception while the Church is in operation. The Church also provides a Night Pastors service. The Night Pastors are on call and have an office next to the room we are using for Stewards Reception. The Minister is Victoria Bravette. Directions to the Methodist Hall on foot: From the Town Hall, walk up the High Street until you reach the end of the pedestrianised area. Carry on a short way up the High Street and Marlborough Road is on the left. The Methodist Church and Hall are on the right, opposite the Library.

Directions to the Methodist Hall by car: Approach is from the M.40 (Junction 11), following signs to Banbury, A422. Turn left at 2<sup>nd</sup> roundabout onto A4260 (Concorde Avenue) At roundabout by Sports Centre continue straight ahead, in right hand lane to some traffic lights. Go straight over into Cherwell Street. Stay in the right hand lane, past Morrison's garage and turn right at the next traffic lights into George Street. Follow the road round to the left into Broad Street. Marlborough road is 2<sup>nd</sup> on the right. The Methodist Hall is on your left, just before the NCP Car Park. We have reserved parking behind the church although space is limited. Please park where Dave the Hat indicates.
